TEWATOHNI'SAKTHA'S PROPOSAL TO HYDRO QUÉBEC COULD MEAN KAHNAWÁ:KE-OWNED WIND FARM

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Kahnawá:ke - 23 Ohiarí:ha/June 2010) Tewatohnhi'saktha is preparing a Kahnawá:ke bid in response to Hydro Quebec's call for tender to purchase 250MW of wind energy from Aboriginal Projects. The proposed wind farm, to be located in St Cyprien, QC, is expected to generate approximately \$2 million per year for Kahnawá:ke. A successful bid to Hydro Québec will generate a steady income for 20 years. Hydro Quebec's deadline for submission is on July 6, 2010.

At the Council meeting on June 22, 2010, the Council of Chiefs confirmed support for the project and authorized Tewatohnhi'saktha to submit a bid on behalf of Kahnawá:ke. A Community information session will take place on Thursday July 1, 2010, from 12:00-1:00 p.m. in the Peacekeeper Community Room.
