Tewatohnhi'saktha Announces Scholarship Fund Recipient

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Kahnawake (April 12, 2011) Tewatohnhi'saktha is pleased to announce that full-time Concordia student Dawn Marquis was selected as the recipient of the first Tewatohnhi'saktha Scholarship Fund award. The Scholarship Fund was established to generate interest in a field of study where currently, only 1% of Kahnawake students are enrolled. The award is a \$3,000 scholarship for undergraduate students completing their degrees in Commerce, Information Technologies, and related fields. Ms. Marquis will be entering into her fourth year of a Bachelor of Commerce degree, majoring in Human Resource Management.

"Ms. Marquis was found to be an outstanding candidate who met all the requirements of the Scholarship Fund. She demonstrated that she is a serious-minded, academically oriented person, and we confirmed her as the recipient without reservation. We are looking forward to repeating the selection process for the winter session," said Tewatohnhi'saktha Board member Tyler Diabo on behalf of the selection committee, which has representatives from Tewatohnhi'saktha, their Board of Directors, and scholarship funding partner Morris Mohawk. Applications from students enrolled in the winter semester are due by October 1, 2011.

Tewatohnhi'saktha will be presenting a cheque to Ms. Marquis at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday April 14, 2011, in their Large Conference Room.
