The scholarship fund was established to generate interest in a field of study where currently, only 1% of Kahnawake students are enrolled. The award is a \$3,000 scholarship for undergraduate students completing their degrees in Commerce, Information Technologies, and related fields. Ms. Marquis will be entering into her fourth semester of a Bachelor of Commerce degree, majoring in Finance.

“Ms. Marquis was found to be an excellent candidate for the scholarship program. Her grades are well above the eligibility requirements, and we hope that this award will help her to maintain her dedication towards her studies,” said Tewatohnhi'saktha Board member Lionel Jacobs. Applications from students enrolled in the winter semester are due by March 1, 2013.
